## AF3: PRESENTATION OF RESEARCH WORK IN NATIONAL OR INTERNATIONAL CONGRESSES.

Number of hours: 50

<u>Description</u>: The number of hours is indicative. The participation of the doctorate students in at least two scientific congresses during the PhD program is recommended. Preferably, these congresses should be of high scientific level and of international character. In these congresses, the student will present an oral communication or a poster.

In any case, is compulsory to make at least two of these activities during the realization of the doctoral thesis. This recommendation is applicable to both, full-time and part-time students. For part-time students, dates and schedules limitations will be taken into consideration.

These activities serve to develop the competencies CB15, CA06 and CE02

<u>Adaptation procedure:</u> Doctorate's tutor will include in the Doctorate Document of Activities all data concerning the works presented in scientific congresses. Particularly, the title and dates of the congress, the title and character of the presentation (poster or oral communication), a summary of the presentation and an attendance certificate will be included. This report will be sent to the CAD, who will include it in the Doctorate Register of Activities

<u>Mobility Actions</u>: Attendance to congresses requires mobility in most cases, and it will be financed with research projects from the research group where the student is participating or with travel grants from the university.
