## AF5: PREPARATION AND PRESENTATION OF TWO FORMAL SEMINARS.

Number of hours: 50

<u>Description</u>: PhD students must prepare and present two formal seminars. The first one will be done within the first 18 months of their studies and will consist on the presentation of the research working plan and the initial results. During the second seminar students will present their results and conclusions as this will serve as a preparation for the PhD thesis defence. This recommendation is applicable to both, full-time and part-time students. For part-time students, dates and schedules limitations will be taken into consideration.

Both seminars can be given at the student's university or during her/his participation at the European School on Molecular Nanoscience (ESMolNa).

The estimated duration includes the preparation of the seminars.

These activities serve to develop the competencies CB15 y CA06

<u>Adaptation procedure</u>: Doctorate's tutor will include in the Doctorate Document of Activities all data concerning the presentations of seminars done by the student. This report will be sent to the CAD, who will include it in the Doctorate Register of Activities.

<u>Mobility actions</u>: In case of local seminars, they do not imply mobility. If the presentations are given at the annual doctoral meeting (ESMolNa), this implies the corresponding mobility associated with the participation to that meeting.
